A hate crime is when something bad happens to you because you have a learning disability.

The person who does it could be someone you know or a stranger.

Hate crimes include:



Someone hitting or kicking you



Someone damaging your things



Being called offensive names



Someone not leaving your house when you ask them to



Someone stealing from you



Receiving obscene phone calls

What should I do if it happens to me?

If you are the victim of a hate crime, it is very important that you report it.



If it's an emergency, call 999



If it is not an emergency but you still want to tell the police, call 101
